RULES

Open to all artists. Must be new artwork not previously shown at Danada House. Only 2 artworks per artist may be submitted.

Send email application + JPEG image to kat@danadahouse.org by March 1st. Or arrange for drop-off of application & image.

On drop off day, entry fee is \$10 for 1st entry, \$5 for 2nd entry. Cash or checks to Friends of Danada. All works must be original, NO AI-generated or computer-generated artwork or prints will be accepted.

Acceptable media: oils, acrylics, watercolors, pastels, pen and ink, pencil, scratchboard, original handmade prints, and airbrush. All works must be framed with wire for hanging (no toothed hangers) Non-compliance may result in disqualification. **Maximum dimensions of artwork is 24" x 36"** framed. Entries may be in color or black and white. **Please include your name, address, phone, email & title of work on back.**

All works submitted must show some aspect of our natural environment with NO indication of human influence (Buildings/sidewalks/etc.). Works must be of United States/North American wildlife, plant life or landscape. All works must clearly qualify under one of the following categories.

Animals - Wildlife only, in an unrestrained setting. Includes furred, finned, feathered, and insects. No jungle animals, no domesticated animals (dogs, cats, other pets, horses, cows or other farm animals). Wild horses in natural areas are okay.

Native Plants - Cultivated plants (house plants or gardens) are not acceptable. Wild plants and trees only.

Landscapes - may include seascapes. All artwork must not give any hint of human presence. Exclude such things as farm scenes, parks, buildings, boats, fences, churches.

Thank you for your interest in the 2026 Friends of Danada Nature Art & Photo Show!

To encourage new entries, winning prints from previous years are ineligible for awards.

All work must be original, new artwork not previously shown at Danada House. The works are juried to eliminate any that do not adhere strictly to the nature theme and are judged for awards on their merit of composition, application of theme and technique. Decisions of the judges shall remain final.
